- All fees are based on a single appointment (15 minutes). Extended appointments may incur additional charges. All charges are inclusive of 15% GST. Double appointments over 14 years = double consultation fee. Double appointments for under 14 years = \$35.00
- All Registered patients with Community Services Cards have a set fee for a standard GP or Nurse consultation or urgent/faxed prescriptions. Adults 18+ = \$19.50 and Children 14 17 years = \$13.00. Additional fees may apply for extra services.
- LATE POLICY: If you are more than 7 minutes late for your consultation you may be asked to reschedule
- **CANCELLATION POLICY:** Failure to give at least **2-hours prior notice** for appointment cancellation will result in a full consultation fee for over 14 year olds and a fee of \$30 for under 14 year olds.
- **DID NOT ATTEND POLICY:** If you fail to attend your appointment and have not arranged to cancel or reschedule you may be charged a **DID NOT ATTEND FEE** as follows:
 - Missed consultation over 14 years = full consultation fee
 - Missed consultation under 14 years = \$30.00
 - Missed funded appointment = \$35.00
 - Missed before school check = \$40.00
- ACCOUNTS POLICY: Payment of all fees are required on the day, if placed on account a \$5.00 administration fee will be incurred. Any accounts that remain unpaid may be referred to a debt collection agency. Any costs incurred in the recovery of payment will be the responsibility of the patient and/or bill payer.
